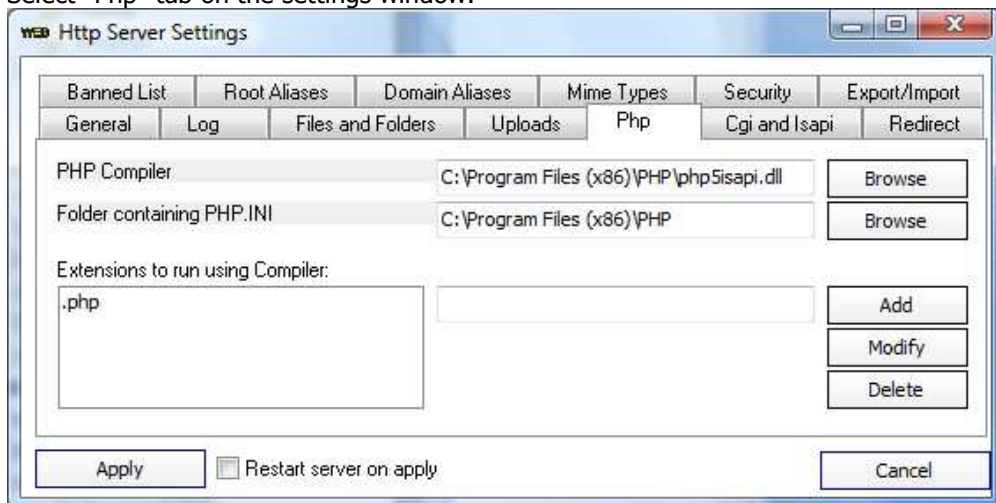


Setting up PHP with Home Web Server

1. After PHP is successfully installed, bring up Home Web Server. Download PHP installation package from PHP web page: <http://www.php.net/downloads.php>.



2. Select "Php" tab on the settings window.



3. Browse PHP installation folder for **php-cgi.exe** file (1). In case you want to use **php5isapi.dll** instead, just change file type – it should exist in very same folder.
4. Browse windows folder to PHP ini path's folder, PHP installer puts folder for the ini file location by default.
5. Add extensions that you want to execute trough the PHP executable, normally php files has the extension ".PHP". **This must be defined to be execute compiler on these.**
6. Finished. Now, if you click open any file with above specified extension, the files should be processed by the PHP compiler and you'll have PHP files working on your Home Web Server.
